### HB23 F-1 VISA SCHOOL ATHLETICS (ANTANI N)

To authorize any student from a country or province outside the United States who holds an F-1 visa to participate in interscholastic athletics

To eliminate the right of first refusal for certain schools in the acquisition of school district real property.
